

Wednesday - July 6 - 1921.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all the commissioners present, the Commissioner as Chairman G. L. Cox presiding.

Cancelled Warrant - Owing to a duplication of vouchers, warrant No. 2891, in favor of B. M. Barber, for \$23.50, was ordered cancelled.

By direction of the Tax Commission he upon request of Alice Sigmon the trustee of the Sigma Kappa Society the board ordered the Kappa Kappa placing of the following described real estate upon the exempt city & county list, to wit: "The South 50 feet of lot 6, block 8, second addition to the city of Lawrence." To remain upon the exempt list so long as the property in question is used for the purpose as indicated in the application.

Claims - Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed, for which see July Allowance Record.

Opening of - The board this date drove to Clinton township and were present at the opening of the Belvoir bridge. They were the guest of Commissioner ~~Steele~~ during their stay in Clinton.

Monthly Report - The monthly report of the Poor Commissioner and the Superintendent of the County Home were received, audited and approved.

City Engineer - By motion made, seconded and passed. The board adopted the following preamble and resolution, to wit:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, together with the county engineer of said County, under date of Wednesday - July 6, 1921, made a personal inspection of the substructure and superstructure work of the Belvoir bridge, work on which has been done by H. E. Stecker of Ottawa, Kansas, the Kansas City Street and Steel Co. of Kansas City, Mo.; and

Whereas, the board finds that all conditions of the contract relating to the construction of the substructure and superstructure have been faithfully complied with, and that the two contracting firms have filed affidavits with the county engineer of said county stating that all bills for labor and material have been paid; therefore, be it
