

Wednesday - July 13 - 1921.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all the Commissioners present, & Commissioner & Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

By direction of the Tax Commission the board ordered a judgment & a pending warrant issued in favor of Mrs. Johna Hill, of Polk County, Iowa, in amount \$14.92, due to error of Township Deputy, Geo. J. West, assessor in charging her with \$1,000, representing a mortgage for that amount, which she did not hold.

The application of Geo. H. Russell for permission to lay a water pipe across the public road at the N. W. corner of S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 17, Twp. 13, R. 19, was granted, with the understanding that the pipe be laid at least 3 feet under ground surface.

The petition of Residents of Endora City & Township, for filed for a road, extending from the east city limits of Endora City to the Johnson County line, was received & ordered filed.

A delegation of Baseline City residents appeared before the Petition Board & asked that that portion of the Old Santa Fe Trails Road extending eastward from the east limits of Baseline City to the Johnson County line, be added. It was heard but action was withheld until a later meeting of the board.

The board took up the final resolution on the matter of the proposed improvement of North 7th street from Locust street north to the north city limits in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, was then offered for adoption; a vote being taken the same was unanimously adopted, as follows, to wit:

Whereas, Heretofore and on the 17th day of June, A.D. 1921, the Board of Commissioners of the city of Lawrence, Kansas, adopted a resolution providing for the paving & improvement of North Seventh street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, from a point commencing at the intersection of Locust street and North Seventh street, thence north along the general line of said North Seventh to the north city limits of said city; providing that said street be paved or otherwise improved at a width of 18 feet with such width at curves as good engineering practice may require, & that the said paving be constructed of concrete according to plans & specifications to be prepared by the city engineer; providing that in order to provide for the payment of the cost of said improvement as may be assessed against the benefit district to be created within said city of Lawrence, the number of assessments to be levied upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land situated therein shall be ten, as the said benefit district shall be in that part of said city of Lawrence, Kansas, embraced within the following boundaries, to wit:

"Beginning at the intersection of the center line of North street with the center
