

Final line of North Seventh street, in that part of the city of Lawrence known as North Lawrence; thence east 528 feet; thence south 2010 feet; thence west 64½ feet, to the west side of lot No. 10 in Simpson's Central subdivision in North Lawrence; thence south 660 feet; thence west 65½ feet; thence south 335½ feet; thence west 1056 feet; thence north 395 feet; thence east 130 feet; thence north 660 feet; thence east 3 feet; thence north 660 feet; thence west 3 feet; thence north 1290 feet; thence east 528 feet, to the point of beginning, all in that part of the city of Lawrence known as North Lawrence.

And providing that upon passage thereof by said board that said resolution be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Douglas, Kansas, for its adoption or further consideration or action, as provided by Chapter 92 of the Laws of Kansas of 1921; and

Whereas, said above-mentioned resolution having been duly certified to the board of County Commissioners of the county of Douglas, Kansas, said board of County Commissioners on June 18-1921, adopted a resolution declaring the proposed improvement as above specified to be a public utility, and providing that as none of said street to be improved lies outside of the city limits of the city of Lawrence, Kansas, no benefit district need be created by said board, providing further that final action on the proposed improvement should be taken on the 13th day of July, 1921, and ordering that notice be given in the official county paper for two consecutive weeks commencing with the issue of June 22-1921, and that on said July 13-1921, said board would hear complaints, protests or objections in writing as might be filed against the proposed improvement; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, on June 20-1921, passed a resolution reciting that the Board of Commissioners of the county of Douglas, Kansas, has adopted the preliminary resolution and has declared the improvement of North Seventh street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, from least street north to the north city limits to be a public utility, and that said Board of Commissioners of the county of Douglas, Kansas, has at July 13-1921, at 9 o'clock A.M. at its office in the Court House in the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, as the time and place for hearing complaints, protests and written objections to said proposed improvement and for taking final action on said resolution, and that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, is required to give notice of such hearing, and ordering that notice be given to all persons affected thereby that complaints, protests and written objections against the proposed improvement will be heard at the office of the County Commissioners in the Court House in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, on July 13-1921, at 9 o'clock A.M. by publishing in the official city paper a copy of the original resolution and of this resolution; and

Whereas, notice was duly published in the Lawrence Daily Journal-World, the official county paper, for the time and in the manner provided by law, of said hearing
