Whereas, Notice was duly published in the Lawrence Daily Journal, the official City paper, for the time and in the manner provided by law, of said hearing of Complaints, protests and written objections against the proposed improvement, proof of which publication has been submitted, and upon consideration of which notice and proof thereof, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, finds that said notice is sufficient and in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided, and does hereby approve and confirm the same; and

Whereas, Upon said hearing of Complaints, protests and written objections, held on July 13-1921, at the offices of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, in the Court house in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with the notice heretofore given, no good reasons are shown to exist why said improvement of North Seventh street from Locust street north to the north City limits should not be made and constructed; therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, first, that all proceedings and actions heretofore had and done be approved; 2^d, That North Seventh street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, be graded, curbed, guttered, paved and otherwise improved from a point commencing at the intersection of Locust street and North Seventh street, thence north along the general line of said North Seventh street to the north City limits of said City; 3^d, That that portion of said North Seventh street lying north of Locust street and south of Maple street be paved at a width of thirty feet with combination of curb and gutter, and that that portion thereof lying north of Maple street be paved at a width of eighteen feet with such width at curves as good engineering practice may require, all of said paving to be constructed of concrete according to plans and specifications to be prepared by the City Engineer of the City of Lawrence, Kansas. The portion of said street lying north of Maple street is not to be curbed but is to have well-graded dirt shoulders not less than six feet wide on either side; 4th, That in order to provide for the payment of the cost of said improvement, in accordance with statute in such case made and provided, as may be assessed against the benefit district to be created within the City of Lawrence, Kansas, the number of assessments to be levied upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land situated therein shall be two, and the said benefit district shall be all that part of said City of Lawrence, Kansas,

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
