

New Road in
Endora
Township

Section 4, Twp. 13, R. 21, thence east 1 mile to the
section line between Sec. 3 & 4 in said township
and range, thence south on said section line to the N.E.
corner of Section 9, Twp. 13, R. 21, in said County.

And instead thereof place upon the list of County roads & declare
the same to be a County road, the following described road, to-wit:

"Beginning at the N.W. corner of Sec. 9, Twp. 13, R. 21,
thence east on the north line of said section to the N.E.

corner thereof & joining the present County road at said point;

The board heard a delegation of Endora City & Endora Township
citizens opposing the change. The board took the mat-
ter under advisement.

By motion duly made & seconded & adopted, the board
passed the following resolution, to-wit:

Resolved, That it be resolved by the board of County Commissioners of
Douglas County, Kansas, in special session this 22nd day of July,
1921, that it is now a necessity that the Patton bridge across
the Wakarusa in Section 10, Twp. 13 S., R. 18 E., in Kanawha
township, be rebuilt, said bridge having been destroyed by
flood July 17, 1920. Be it

Further resolved, That upon the approved estimate, plans
and specifications of said work as prepared by the County
Engineer, B. L. Wolfe, being filed with the County clerk of
Douglas County the said County clerk shall advertise for bids
on said work in accordance with Chapter 80, Laws of 1917,
state of Kansas. Be it

Further resolved, That a tax be levied in an amount to
cover the cost of said bridge, said tax not to exceed one
(1) mill on the assessed valuation of the property in Douglas
County, Kansas.
