

Monday - August 1 - 1921

Ordered The board directed the clerk to purchase a 4-drawer steel filing cabinet, letter size, for filing the District Court Sten. Joseph's original notes. The cabinet to be placed in the clerk of the District Court's office.

Approved The monthly reports of the C. Farm & Home Dept. were received, audited and approved.

Tuesday - August 2 - 1921 -

The board met in adjourned Regular Session, all the Commissioners present, the Commissioner the Chairman G. L. Cox presiding.

Ordered By Motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board ordered a collection of the 1920 tax against the W. 40 ft. of lot 9, block 3, South Lawrence, extended as expense for road cutting. The same action was taken with Tax in Lawrence against the 1913 tax, interest was paid, for the 1920 tax the penalties on lot 9, block 3, Chapel street, Burlington City, the same being a street, extended on the tax roll as Baldwin & Sons tax.

Approved The board received a letter request from the Ziegler & Deaton Construction Co., contractors on Section D. E. 3, Project #7, Fort to Fort Highway, for permission to sublet to the firm of Miley & Kelly the two west miles of that portion of this contract known as Section 7, Project #7, L. H.
