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Joint Meet.

A meeting of the joint board composed of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 42 of the Session Laws of Kansas of 1921, was convened this date, at 10 o'clock A.M. The joint board was organized by the election of H. L. Cox, chairman of the Douglas County Board of Commissioners, as chairman, and Geo. W. Brown, clerk of the Douglas County Board of Commissioners, as clerk. The joint meeting was held to take on for consideration and action the bids made by various contractors for doing the proposed improvement of North 7th street from Locust street north to the north city limits in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, in accordance with the resolution of the joint board of August 10, 1921, and in accordance with notices published in the official county paper and in the official city paper setting August 27, 1921, 10 o'clock A.M., as the date and time on which said bids would be opened and considered.

Proof of publication of the notice as published in the official county paper, and proof of publication of the notice as published in the official city paper were submitted, and upon consideration of said notices and proof thereof, the board finds that said notices are in accordance with statute and have been published in the time and manner as required by statute, and does hereby approve and confirm the same.

Bids Open. Therefore all bids received by the County clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and the city clerk of Lawrence, Kansas, in accordance with notice published as heretofore shown, namely, The Cook & O'Brien Const. Co., and H. S. K. Co., Harry Tied of Hutchinson, Kansas, and A. R. Young & Co. of N. 7th St., were opened and considered by the board, and after due consideration thereof, said joint board finds that the A. R. Young Construction Company, whose bid for the construction of said improvement, in accordance with the survey, plans and specifications, is \$24,581.00, is the lowest and best bidder, and should be awarded the contract for the making of said proposed improvement of North 7th street as proposed.

Contract. It is therefore ordered by the joint board, composed of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and the joint action of each of said boards concurring therein, that the contract for making and doing the proposed improvement of North 7th street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, from Locust street north to the north city limits, in accordance with the plans, specifications and survey, be awarded to the A. R. Young Construction Co. at the contract price of \$24,581.00, and set out in its proposal, it being the lowest and best bidder for the making

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
