Appraisal

Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed, for which see September Allowance Report. The minutes of the board meeting during August were read by the clerk, and upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, were approved.

Thursday, Sept. 8-1921.

The board met in Adjourned regular session, all the commissioners present, Mr. Commissioner and Chairman G. K. Cox presiding.

The board, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, adopted the following resolution, to-wit:

Whereas, the road lying along the north line of the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Twp. 13, Range 20, from the west end of said tract of land to the A. T. & S. F. Ry. Co. right-of-way is in its present condition too narrow and so low that proper drainage of said road cannot be had, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 8th day of September, 1921, that it is necessary to widen said road twenty feet to the south of said road along its full length for the proper construction of said road, be it further

Resolved, that this board obtain by purchase or donation said strip of land twenty feet wide along the full ~~width~~ length of said road from the owner thereof, M. A. Walker, and if the said strip of land cannot be obtained from said M. A. Walker for or less this board shall condemn said strip of land for the purpose above mentioned, as provided in chapter 226 of the Laws of Kansas for 1921.

By motion duly made, seconded and passed the board, acting upon the statement of the County attorney that their previous action was illegal, adopted the following resolution, to-wit:

Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 8th day of September, 1921, that the action of this board at the meeting of August 10, 1921, authorizing striking from the list of County roads the following described part of a road, to-wit: "Beginning at the intersection of Seventh street, extended, in Eudora, with the west line of Section 4, Township 13, Range 21, thence east one mile to the section line between Sections 3 and 4,
