Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 15th day of September, 1921, that the costs of administration of the estate of the late Dr. Mark Beach, to-wit: Appointment of guardian, \$5.45; proceedings relative to the sale of real estate, \$5.00; additional bond, \$1.65, a total of \$12.10, for and the same is hereby allowed; and

Further Resolved, That a copy of this order of the Board be transmitted to the Probate Court of Douglas County, Kansas, for their records.
