Notice of Widening a Highway.

Pursuant to resolutions dated September 8-1921, and October 12-1921, in which the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, determined that it was necessary that a certain road be widened for the proper construction of a highway, tract: "The road lying along the north line of the south one-half of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 20, Township 13, Range 20, in Douglas County, Kansas, from the northwest corner of said south one-half of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 20, Township 13, Range 20, east to the A. T. & S. Fe Ry. right of way," and that it was necessary that said road be widened twenty feet to the south along the entire length, and that said road and the land to be taken be viewed on the 29th day of October, 1921, according to law, and the value thereof and the damages thereof be appraised, notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, will begin to view said road and the charges required as provided in said resolutions on the 29th day of October, 1921, at 10 o'clock a.m., at the west end of said road herein described and will give all parties interested a hearing.
