

Monday, Nov. 7-1921.

The board met this date for the first day of the November session. All members of the board were present, ex. Commissioner and Chairman A. L. Cox presided.

By motion duly made, seconded and passed the board directed credit to Consolidation, in total amount \$217.95, in tax collected on estates settled by Treas. ad. against persons having no state, on the basis of 1920 Tax Levy (collected under Tax Paid prior to the buying date 1921 Tax) charged to estates of individuals, as here follow, to wit:
