By motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board adopted the following preamble and resolution, to wit:

Order Prop. Whereas, It now appears that the following described tract, to-wit: "All of lot 167 and the south 12½ feet of lot 165 Lawrence street, City of Lawrence, County of Douglas, State of Kansas," is now owned by the Association of Sigma Gamma Phi Beta;

Whereas, the said above described real estate is now used for the purposes mentioned in Section 11153 of the General Statutes of the State of Kansas for 1915; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Bd. of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the said above described real estate, together with all books, furniture, apparatus and instruments thereto belonging to said organization be, and the same is hereby stricken from the tax rolls of Douglas County, Kansas.
