The board met in regular session, all the Commissioners present, Chairman G. R. Cox presiding.

Order The board ordered refunds to following persons for taxes paid on erroneous assessment of personal property, Town of N. S. Foster, on one male dog, \$1.00, Mrs. W. Weyersmiller, \$5.76, account failure of deputy assessor to grant constitutional exemption.

Geo. Miller This was the day set for hearing the Geo. E. Miller and Geo. L. McCarty road petitions. After deliberation the board rejected the Geo. E. Miller petition, & granted the prayer of the Geo. L. McCarty petitioners, with the understanding that the road ^{side} be changed to bound the entire length, and with the further understanding that the action of this board must with the approval of the State Highway Commission.

Order Property By direction of the State Tax Commission the Bd. ordered exemption of lot 167 & the south 12 1/2' of lot 165 Town of Lawrence, owned by the Association of Sigma & Gamma Phi Bets.
