

Saturday, Mar 26-1921-

The board met in regular session, all the Commissioners present, the Commissioner & Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

By order of the State Tax Commission, the board ordered Order for a cancellation of \$800 personal property valuation appearing in the Canfield name of Louis R. Duvillier on the 1921 tax roll, represented by a Tax Return mortgage for that amount, it appearing there satisfaction of the full bond that he was erroneously assessed for that amount.

The board also ordered a refund to Mrs. Eda D. Wieman of \$4.77, account no exemption allowed.

Thursday, Mar 29-1921

The board met in regular session, all the Commissioners present, and Commissioner and Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

By motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:
