

Resolved - Beginning at a point where the South city limits of the city of
H.C. Paul decomposition intersects the section line between Sections 2 and 3, Twp.
Sptm 12, Rge. 18 in Douglas County, Kansas, thence South on the line
after 1/2 between Sections 10 and 11, 14 and 15, and 22 and 23, said township and range
road to the point where said road intersects the Fort to Fort Highway.
Highway and

Commissioner - Where as said latter road cannot be made a county road
until some other road is withdrawn, the county system of
roads being now full.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, by The Board of County Commissioners
of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session this 27th day of
November, 1921, that said road first above described be with-
drawn from the county road system of this County and cease
to be a county road and that upon the approval of this
resolution by the State Highway Engineer, this resolution be
spread upon the Journal of this Board, and be in full
force and effect as provided by Law.
