

Tuesday Dec. 27-1921-

The board met in regular session at 10:00 o'clock A.M. All three Commissioners of the County Clerk were present. Chairman Cox presided.

Commissioner Stueb offered the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Commissioner Rutledge, Trust.

Order Change Whereas, on the 17th day of October, 1921, this board duly in doing passed a resolution providing for the issuance of negotiable bonds of ^{Douglas} County in the sum of \$200,000.00 for the purpose of issuing paying the expense of building the road known as the Fort to Fort Highway, Project #7, Section D. E. & F, all in Benoit District No. 2, in Douglas County, Kansas, said bonds to be dated January 1-1922, and

Whereas, it has since been brought to the attention of this board that January 1, 1922, falls upon a Sunday, and it is deemed desirable that said bonds should not be dated on Sunday; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, by this Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 27th day of December, 1921, that said resolution of October 17, 1921, be, and the same is hereby amended so that the date of the execution of all said bonds in the aggregate sum of \$200,000.00 shall be January 2-1922, and all the interest coupons thereto attached shall so unite and be payable on the first days of July and January in each year. Said resolution of October 17, 1921, is hereby repealed, ratified and confirmed by this board, as so amended, in all other respects, and all said bonds shall be dated January 2, 1922, and the interest coupons thereto attached shall so unite.

After discussion the foregoing resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of all the three members of the board.
