Reports The monthly report of the Commissioner of the Poor was received, audited and approved.

Orders Tax The Board authorized the cancellation of tax amounting to \$19.17, cancellation appearing against the Douglas County Farm Bureau on the 1921 tax roll on a valuation of \$600.00, because being of a scientific and educational nature, such property comes within the exemption contained in the tax law and is not subject to taxation.

By motion duly made, seconded and passed, the Board unanimously adopted the following resolution, to wit:
