Saturday, February 11-1922

The board met in adjourned regular session, Commissioners Stule and Kettinger present, Commissioner Cox absent owing to sickness. Commissioner Stule Chairman, R. A. Stule presided.

The board gave following persons, appointed Deputy Assessors, approved and received approval, to wit: Geo. Hildner, Leda C. McPherson, Geo. Engelbarger, F. J. Pallett, A. E. Owen, Bruce Knochel, Leora Douglas, Leora Williams.

The annual report of the Trustee of Marion Township was received and approved.

By direction of the State Tax Commission the board ordered cancellation of tax, in amount \$8.23, on a valuation of \$250.00, assessed against the Elmer Co. Operation House, in the city of Lawrence, due and paid that the property was doubly assessed.

By action duly made, recorded and passed, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 11th day of February, 1922, that the following real estate property be placed on the non-taxable list on Exempt of Douglas County, Kansas, said property being described as follows: Lots 214, 216 and 218, all on Louisiana St. in the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas. That said property be placed on the tax exempt list for the following reasons, to wit: Said property being owned by and in the name of the Beta Gamma Chapter of the Phi Kappa Alpha fraternity, a fraternity duly organized and existing under the by laws of the State of Kansas; that said property is used exclusively as a literary hall and dormitory for the purpose of education, and therefore comes within the same category as under the same rules as all other fraternity houses at the University of Kansas, and therefore being exempt from taxation; and to remain tax exempt so long as said property shall be used for the purpose indicated above.
