

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, of block 31, of the same addition, be placed upon the tax exempt list of Douglas County, Kansas, for the following reasons, to wit: That said lots 1 to 12 inclusive, block 30, and lots 1 to 12 inclusive, block 31, in Quinera Place, and addition to the city of Lawrence, have been acquired by the University Memorial Corporation upon which to erect a stadium to be used for educational purposes in connection with the University of Kansas, and that while the title rests in this corporation it really belongs to the State University, and under the laws of the State of Kansas is therefore tax exempt.

Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the State Tax Commission for their examination and action thereon.

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Upon motion duly made, seconded, and passed, the Board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

Now on the 25th day of February, 1922, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, comes on for hearing the petition of Gamma Sigma, an unincorporated association of women students of the University of Kansas, praying that lot 148 Tennessee Street, in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, be removed from the tax roll and placed upon the list of tax exempt property of Douglas County, Kansas.

And it appearing that said Gamma Sigma sorority is a sorority duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas as a voluntary association, and under the rules and regulations of the University of Kansas; that said property is owned by said sorority and occupied and used by the members thereof exclusively as a literary hall and dormitory, and not for profit, and is therefore within the purview of Paragraph 11153, General Statutes of Kansas, 1915, it is therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 25th day of February, 1922.

Resolved, that lot 148 Tennessee Street, in the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, be and it is hereby removed from the tax roll of said county and placed upon the list of tax exempt property of said county, there to remain so long as said property is owned and used for the purpose as indicated above.
