

Monday, March 6-1922

The board met this date for the first day of the March session. Commissioner & Chairman Robt. A. Stule was present & presided. Commissioner Cox was absent owing to sickness. Commissioner Kutzinger was absent owing to the serious illness of his wife. Commissioner Kutzinger deputized County Clerk Geo. C. Boone to act in his capacity.

Claims Allowed. Claims against the County were presented, audited & allowed, for which see March Allowance Record.

Admission. Upon recommendation of the County Health Officer Armstrong & Co. Physician Lewis Armstrong was admitted to Blue Cross Hospital, Roswell, Kansas for treatment, for a period of 3 weeks.

Project Lett. The claim of Lett Ingalls, for \$17.50, was rejected.

Tuesday, March 7-1922.

The board met this date in adjourned regular session. Commissioner & Chairman Robt. A. Stule presiding. County Clerk Geo. C. Boone as proxy for Commissioner Kutzinger.

Approve Reports. The annual report of the Superintendent John C. Home was read, and the monthly reports of the Commissioner John P. Cox and the Superintendent John C. Home were read, were received, scrutinized and approved.

Claims Allowed. Claims against the County were presented, audited & allowed, for which see March Allowance Record.

Appoint. The sickness of Deputy Assessor G. T. Deen of Cedar Township necessitated the appointment of a second deputy & upon recommendation of the County Assessor & by motion made, seconded and passed. Mr. Paul Stanley was named as such assistant deputy, to serve until the regular deputy can again assume his duties.

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Saturday, March 18-1922.

The board, composed of Commissioners & Chairman Stule & County Clerk Boone as proxy for Commissioner Kutzinger, met this date in adjourned regular session.

Upon recommendation of the County Attorney, & by motion made, 2d & passed, M. E. Miller, arrested & held in jail for 30 days & a fine of \$500 & costs, was ordered released from custody.
