1. Motion Road The board, with reference to the Metsker road petition, offered Mrs. E. G. Kind, owner of the strip which it is proposed to take for widening the road, \$50 in cash and 600 lbs. of black wire and staples, which Mrs. A. A. Weber, acting as agent for Mrs. Kind, accepted.

By motion duly made, seconded, and passed. The board adopted the following resolution to wit:

Order Certain Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 12th day of April, 1922, That the following described real estate property be placed on the non-taxable list of Douglas County, to wit: The East 1/2 of lot 4, High street, Baldwin City, Kansas, excepting the upper story of the two-story structure ~~there~~ on said lot, said upper story being owned and used by Palmyra Lodge No. 23, A. F. & A. M. That said property, with the exception noted, be placed on the tax exempt list for the following reason, to wit: Said property being owned by and in the name of the Lloyd Beaton Post No. 228, American Legion, Department of Kansas, and by authority of Section 1, Chapter 321, Laws of Kansas, 1917, and Section 1, Chapter 255, Laws of Kansas 1921, is tax exempt, so long as said property shall be owned and used for the purpose indicated in the application, namely, used for the purpose of the American Legion and others as provided for the laws governing such a case.
