Cancel taxes for the years 1905, amount \$53.76; 1906, \$51.78; 1907, \$49.80; 1908, \$47.82, plus all interest and fees thereon, on property standing in the name of the city of Lawrence, and described on page 64, sale #302 of the sale of 1906, as follows: Beginning at NW. cor. of Park lot #16, thence N. 100 ft., E. 350 ft., S. 100 ft., W. 350 ft. to beginning. Cancellation is hereby ordered made on account of this property being owned by the city of Lawrence and therefore not subject to taxation.
