

Monday, May 15 - 1922

The Board met in adjourned session, all the commissioners present, the Commissioner the Chairman Robt. A. State presiding.

After discussion, the upon motion made by Commissioner [unclear] seconded by Commissioner [unclear] the passed by a vote of 3 yeas and no nays, the Board adopted the following resolution, to-wit:

Be it Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas, in regular session this 15th day of May, 1922, that pursuant to law it is hereby ordered that for the purpose of paying the expense of building the road known as the Fort to Fort Highway, Project No. 7, Sections D, E and F, all in Benefit District No. 2, in Douglas county, Kansas, as per contracts entered into according to law, there be issued bonds of Douglas county, Kansas in the amount of \$82,000, same to be dated July 1, 1922, to draw interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent, payable semiannually, principal and interest payable at the office of the State Treasurer of Kansas, at Topeka, Kansas, \$41,000 of said bonds to be of \$500 denomination and \$41,000 to be of \$1,000 denomination; \$10,000 to fall due July 1, 1923, and \$8,000 of said bonds to become due each year thereafter; And that the full faith and credit of Douglas county, Kansas, be and the same is hereby pledged for the payment of said bonds and the interest thereon; and that the chairman of this board is hereby authorized to sign said bonds and interest coupons there-to attached, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to attest said bonds and coupons with his signature and the seal of Douglas county, and that said coupons may be so signed and attested by the facsimile signature of chairman and clerk; and further, that said bonds be advertised and sold according to law.

The Board, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, authorized the County Clerk to designate the 1st day of June, 1922, at 11:00 o'clock a.m., in the official publication calling for bids on the \$82,000 Road Improvement bonds to be issued by the county, as the day and hour upon which bids for the purchase of these bonds will be received and opened.

In compliance with the resolution above set forth the clerk submitted a copy of the advertisement to be published in the official county paper calling for bids on the \$82,000 Road Improvement bonds, which copy, after being read by the clerk, was, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved by the Board, to-wit:
