

Whereas, the type of the proposed improvements, the width of the
 Sup. and road way, and further stated that said improvement should
 be paid for in twenty annual assessments to be levied upon
 the lands in said benefit district and from all other sources
 provided by law for such purposes; and

Whereas, after proceeding in the manner provided by law
 said petition came on for final consideration and action
 by this board, and after careful inquiry and consideration
 said board declared, ordered and found that the improvement
 prayed for is of public utility, and that said petition
 complied in all respects with the laws of Kansas; and
 Whereas, at a regular meeting of this board a resolution was
 adopted directing that said road be improved as prayed
 for, and that the County Engineer of Douglas County cause
 accurate surveys to be made, together with profiles and
 maps of the benefit district, plans and specifications for the
 improvements, and estimates of cost of such improvement;
 and after final approval of such plans, specifications, pro-
 files and estimate by the State Highway Engineer, that
 they be filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas,
 and

Whereas, The County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, has her-
 tofore caused an accurate survey to be made of said road,
 together with a profile and map of the benefit district, and
 the plans and specifications of the improvement prayed for, the
 estimate of the cost of such improvement, and has caused the
 same to be submitted to the Kansas Highway Engineer for his con-
 sideration and approval; and

Whereas, said surveys, profiles, maps, specifications and esti-
 mates of cost were by the Kansas State Highway Engineer duly
 approved and by this board ordered filed with the County Clerk
 of Douglas county, Kansas, as required by law; and

Whereas, said board of county Commissioners of Douglas County,
 Kansas, have proceeded and are now proceeding to have said
 permanent road constructed in accordance with the petitions,
 surveys, profiles, maps, specifications, estimates, and in all respects
 as required by law; and

Whereas, The total estimated cost of said improvements, as
 shown by the approved estimates on file with the County Clerk
 of Douglas county, and as hereby found and determined by
 this board is as follows: Fort & Fort Highway, Project no. 7,
 sections A, B, C, D, E, F, and G, \$956,876.16; and

Whereas, Douglas county has heretofore issued its
