Said bonds and interest coupons shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer, in the city of Topeka, Kansas, (being the fiscal agency of the State of Kansas), and the full faith credit and all of the resources of Douglas County, Kansas, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said bonds and the interest coupons as the same severally mature, said bonds shall be numbered, in denomination, amount due and be come due and payable as follows:
