Know All Men By These Presents, That the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, acknowledges itself indebted to and for value received hereby promises to pay to the bearer the sum of

lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of July, 19 —, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of January and July of each year, on the presentation of the interest coupons hereto attached as they severally become due, both principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States of America, at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas, and for prompt payment of the principal and interest on this bond when due the full faith, credit and resource of Douglas County, Kansas, are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This Bond is one of a series of one hundred and twenty-three (123) bonds of like date and tenor except as to denomination and maturity, numbered from one to one hundred twenty-three (1 to 123) inclusive, amounting in the aggregate to eighty-two thousand (\$82,000) dollars, issued for the purpose of the creation of a fund for the payment of the cost and expense of building permanent roads in Douglas County, Kansas, by authority of and in compliance with the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, including Chapter 265, Laws of Kansas, 1917, and amendments, complimentary and supplemental thereto, and proceedings legally and duly had in accordance therewith.

It is hereby certified and recited, that all conditions, acts, and things required by the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, to exist, happened or be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have existed, happened and been properly done and performed in legal and due form and time as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of the county, including this issue of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.
