Same shall be deposited in the fund for the payment of said improvements, and the Board of County Commissioners shall annually levy upon all the taxable property in Douglas county liable therefor, a tax sufficient to produce a fund to pay off the bonds and interest coupons described herein as they severally mature; and said Board hereby irrevocably binds itself and Douglas County, Kansas, during the life of said bonds to levy and collect such tax and retire said bonds and coupons at maturity.

Section 5. This resolution is supplemental to a resolution adopted by this Board on the 15th day of May, 1922, providing for the issuance of the above-described bonds.

Section 6. This resolution shall be in force and take effect from and after this 16th day of June, 1922.
