

Monday, July 3, 1922

The board met this date for the first day of the July session, Commissioners Stule, Kettinger and Hooper & Clark Brown present. Commissioner as Chair, man Robt. A. Stule presided.

Referred to file By order of the Tax Commission, the board directed M. Nelson that a refund of \$23.00 be made to the M. Nelson, of Laurens, on a showing that she had been erroneously assessed on personal property amount \$700.00.

Referred to file Upon like order, the board ordered a refund of \$83.25 to Geo. W. Snow, of Grant township, school district #63, upon a showing that he had been erroneously assessed on personal property in amount \$5,000.00.

Referred to file Upon like order, the board directed that a refunding of \$89.01 be made to the Brother Hardware & Furniture Co., of Osceola, for \$89.01, due to erroneous assessment of personal property in amount \$2,850.

General Remarks The clerk asked that County warrants, amounting to \$103.08, which have been held for a period longer than three years, be cancelled, which request was, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, granted.

Approved Quarterly The quarterly reports of the County Treasurer, County Clerk, Probate Judge were received, audited, and approved. Claims Allowed Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed, for which see July Allowance Record.
