Received Douglas The Board received the Budget for the Douglas County, Kansas Farm Bureau for the period from January 1-1923, to December 31-1923, and ordered the clerk to file it.

The following resolution, introduced by Commissioner Kutsinger, and by motion duly made and seconded, was passed by the unanimous vote of the board, to wit:

Pass Resolution Asking Federal Commission for Authority to make special tax levy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in session this 12th day of July, 1922, that:

WHEREAS, the warrants outstanding against the General Fund of Douglas County, Kansas exceed the amount of money in said General Fund in the sum of \$4,091.97, and

WHEREAS, the estimated expenses for the months of July, August, September and October to be paid out of the General Fund is \$25,727.23, and

WHEREAS, the estimated receipts to be received in said Fund before the end of the fiscal year 1922 is \$1,650. This amount received is the quarterly fees, fines and penalties, etc., and

WHEREAS, the rate of taxation for General Fund of Douglas County, Kansas, is 1.14 mills, and the valuation of Douglas County for the year 1921 is \$4,622,154.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved that this Board make application to the Tax Commission of the State of Kansas, that said Tax Commission order the issuance of General Warrants Funds from Douglas County, Kansas, in the amount necessary to pay the expenses to be paid from said Fund for the months of July, August, September and October, 1922, and not to exceed 25% of 1.14 mills or .0285 mills, the same being equivalent to, and authorizing said warrants to issue in a sum not exceeding \$13,307.00.
