

Monday, Sept. 4 - 1922.

Holiday - This being a legal holiday, the board transacted no business, adjournment being taken until Tuesday, Sept. 5 - 1922.

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The board met in adjourned regular session, Commissioners Steele and Horsford being present, also the County Clerk. Commissioner Kretzinger was absent. Commissioner Steele presided.

Order Refund - The board, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, ordered a refund of \$60.29 to F. Bleed, of Wakarusa Township, paid under protest on money invested in government bonds.

Approve Re - The petition of La Fave Bailey and 12 others asking that Fort Thomas be added to the City of Lawrence, the vacated was upon the motion duly made, seconded and passed. It was explained that the plot for addition is incorrect in several important particulars, but it is desired to withdraw the present plat and submit one which is correct in every particular.

Officially Op. With reference to the various claims for damages accruing from the widening of the road petitioned for by M. H. Butler and others, the board, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved the amounts tentatively agreed to at the meeting of Butler and Saturday, August 19 - 1922, he authorized the issuance of county warrants for amounts as stated upon delivery of quit claim deeds from the various individuals to the county.
