Board Open The board took up the various bids for supplying the County with coal for the coming winter and spring, of which five were received, as follows:

O. M. Smith, \$10.⁰⁰ a ton delivered in Court house & jail, at \$9.⁰⁰ a ton on track at India.

University Coal Co., \$10.²⁵ delivered, \$10.⁰⁰ on track at India.

Kan Valley Coal Co., \$10.⁵⁰ delivered, \$10.⁰⁰ on track at India.

Ligon Moore Lumber Co., \$10.⁷⁵ delivered, no quotation on track

Griffin Coal Co., \$9.²⁵ delivered, \$9.²⁵ on track at India

Answer It was finally determined, after discussion as to reliability and ability to deliver to fulfill a contract, to award the contract to Orlay M. Smith at \$10.²⁵ a ton delivered in basement of Court house & jail, O. M. Smith at \$9.⁰⁰ a ton on track at India. Mr. Smith further agreed that in the event of a reduction in price to him or reduction in freight rates, to give the County the benefit of such reduction.
