By motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board ordered a cancellation of tax appearing on the 1922 tax roll against the Malby Revolving Hammock Co. of Baldwin, owing to error made by deputy assessor, and to accept in lieu thereof a subsequent statement showing an assessed valuation of \$2,470.00, upon which the tax shall be \$88.88.

Also, on account of not getting the board's findings to the County Clerk adjusting the valuation on lots on lots 11-16, 11 and 16, block 172, city of Endora, the clerk is hereby notified, by motion duly made, seconded, and passed, that the adjustment made was a valuation of \$2,400.00 on buildings on lot 11, and the valuation on land on lot 16, of \$10.00, and \$50.00 on building.
