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to be taxed for such improvements are included in the Port to Port Benefit Road District No. 2, hereby created, and said district shall consist of all the following described lands and none other, within the boundaries herein described, as follows:

The southern boundary of Benefit District No. two, West of the City of Lawrence, in Township 18 S. of Range 18 E. 6th P. M. Begin at the S. E. Cor. of the center of Sec. 27, thence North of the North line of Sec. 27, thence West to the S. E. Cor. of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 19, thence North to the center of Sec. 18, thence West to the west line of Sec. 18, thence in Twp. 18 S. of Range 18 E. of the 6th P. M. West on the gr. sec. line in Sec. 13 to the gr. sec. cor. bet. sec. 13 and 14, thence North to the gr. sec. cor. bet. gr. sec. cor. bet. secs. 9 and 10, thence North to the cor. of Secs. 3-4-5-10, thence West on the Sec. line between Secs. 4 and 5, 5 and 6, and 6 and 7 to the cor. of Secs. 6-7-1-12; thence in Twp. 18 S. of Range 18 E. of 6th P. S. on the gr. sec. line in Sec. 5 to the gr. sec. cor. bet. Secs. 5 and 8, thence E. on the sec. line bet. Secs. 5 and 8, 4 and 9 to the gr. sec. cor. bet. Secs. 4 and 9, thence S. on the gr. sec. line to the center of Sec. 9; th. E. on the sec. line in Secs. 9-10 and 11 to a point 12.17 chains west of the center of Sec. 11 thence S. to the Wakaruse Creek, thence Easterly along the center line of said Creek to the S. line of the N. W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 11, thence east to the W. line of the E. 85 acres of said S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 11 (being the 85 acres owned by E.O. Which said descriptions are made a part of this petition for the purpose of fixing and defining the territory included in said district and the boundaries thereof. The improvements herein prayed for are to be paid from ten annual assessments to be levied upon the lands above described constituting said Benefit Road District.

We further request your Honorable Body to find and declare said road improvements to be a public utility by order of your board and to make and order said improvements to be made and paid for and that all necessary action therefore be taken as prescribed in Senate Bill No. 576, House Bill No. 301 and Senate Bill No. 593 enacted into law by the Legislature of Kansas of 1917.
