

January 8 - 1923

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The Board of Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, with commissioners E. B. Hosford, G. E. Nutsinger, Robert G. Sterle and County Clerk E. C. Bussing also the out-going County Clerk Geo. C. Brund. This being the time for organization of the board, County Clerk Bussing acted as chairman. G. E. Nutsinger was unanimously elected as chairman of the board for the ensuing year (1923). Mr. Nutsinger took the chair. Mr. Hosford was elected chairman pro tem. County clerk presented the applications of Dr. J. T. Jones and Dr. E. R. Keith for the office of county physician. Mr. Keith was elected by unanimous vote.

Harry Gillum was unanimously elected custodian of the Court house for the year at a salary of \$90.00 per month & \$2.00 allowance for laundry.

The Journal Herald was designated as the official paper for the county.

The board instructed the clerk to cancel the Interest and penalty on L.W. 44 - Sec 11 - Trp 14 R 18 on request of Arthur H. Bennett for the reason that Mr. Bennett was charged this amount by his company and the non-payment was by no fault of his.

January 10 - 1923
