Oklawaha townships and Al Gruber, to consider
the matter of repairing the road south of the
Gruber farm to the county road. They returned
to the Court house and called into the county
attorney remaining in session all afternoon
discussing the problem and hearing the views
of the interested parties from that neighborhood.
At six o'clock they adjourned to meet again at
the same place on the 20th of January at 9 A.M.
(The above meeting was all held at the
Court house.)
