

approved by the Highway commission, appropriating the State Aid road fund of Douglas County, to the payment of the costs of the Fort to Fort hard surfaced road through Douglas County; that the amount of Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) now in said State Aid road fund, be transferred, subject to the approval of the State Highway commission, to Douglas County for reimbursement for cost of said Fort to Fort hard surfaced road, fifty (50) per cent to Douglas County, twenty (20) per cent to the townships through which said road runs and twenty (20) per cent to the benefit district.

That the county clerk is hereby instructed to forward all necessary papers and information to the State Highway Commission for their approval.

Copy of resolutions of Jan 7-1922, referred to above, statement from engineer, in duplicate, showing costs and a certified statement from county treasurer, H. H. McKone setting for the amount \$53,661.84 now held in Douglas County in the State Aid road fund, were executed and forwarded to the State Highway commission by the county clerk.

The following resolution passed unanimously, viz: Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas in regular session this 10th day of February 1923, that the fine of Will Dick, amounting to three hundred dollars (\$300.00) be and the same is hereby remitted, for the reason that Harry Dick this partner has paid a fine of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs in his case and also the costs in the case of Will Dick, and further that each pled guilty and did not put the county to heavy costs for conviction.

The road petition signed by F. L. Hartman and twenty-two others was rejected for the reason that it does not connect with any other open road at its western point of termination.
