

Tuesday - February 26 - 1923

The Board of Commissioners met in Special Session and passed, unanimously the following resolution. —

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Com. of Douglas County, Kansas, in special session this 26th day of February 1923, that whereas Oliver Hunter has served sixty (60) days sentence imposed upon him in the case of the State of Kansas vs Oliver Hunter and has no funds with which to pay the fine and costs, that said Oliver Hunter be released by the Sheriff of Douglas County on his, the said Oliver Hunter signing an agreement with the board of county commissioners to pay the costs of said action at the rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per month, the first payment of which is to be made by the said Oliver Hunter on the first day March 1923.

Agreement —

This agreement made and entered into by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the first and Oliver Hunter party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the party of the first part remitting the fine of \$200.00 imposed against the party of the second part in the case of the State of Kansas vs Oliver Hunter, the said party of the second part hereby covenants and agrees to pay to the party of the first part the costs in the case of the State of Kansas vs Oliver Hunter, the same being \$64.00 at the rate of \$1.00 per month until said costs are fully paid. The first payment of which is to be made on the first day of March 1923.
