

Saturday March 10-1923

Board met in adjourned regular session present Kutsinger, Steele and Macford

Board order refund of 4th to Mrs M. Ripley of Palmyra for the reason no exemption had been allowed when she was assessed.

Board ordered a change in the valuation on N. 120 ft of West 2^d of Block 50 West Lawrence less E. 48 ft, belonging to S. W. Salisbury, from \$500.00 to \$200 for future tax and also ordered a refund of \$9.30 for the reason that a mistake was made in the amount of land included in the description when assessed

Charlotte C. Walker appeared before the board with a written application, asking that the property belonging to the University of W. C. A known as the "Holly Home" be exempt from taxation. The board passed the following resolution unanimously.

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Com. of Douglas county, State of Kansas in regular session this 10th day of March 1923, that whereas the following described property is now owned and controlled by the Young Women's Christian Association of the University of Kansas and that said property is entitled to exemption from taxation under section 1151 S. S. 1915, therefore we the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas recommend to the State Tax Commission that the following described property be exempted from taxation and that the County Clerk of Douglas county, State of Kansas be instructed to mark the same exempt on the tax rolls of the county

Description - Lot number seven (7) and that part of lot number six (6) described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of said lot number (6) thence west (25) feet along the north line of said lot, thence south along the line between lot number (6) and lot number seven (7) twenty-five (25) feet, thence east parallel to the north line of said lot twenty-five (25) feet, thence north along the east
