The Board of County Commissioners met in special session, the three members were all present.

The following resolution was passed unanimously.

Be It Resolved by the board of county commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas, in special session this 17th day of March 1923, that the county treasurer be and is hereby instructed to transfer the money in the Patton Bridge Fund amounting to \$2123.98 to the Bridge Fund.

The following resolution passed unanimously
Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas, in special session, this 17th day of March 1923, that the petition of Charles R. Cox and 33 others for a change of the county road, from the present location to another location, according to the description contained in said petition, which description here follows:-

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of fifteenth street with the east line of Haskell Avenue in the city of Lawrence, run east one and one-fourth (1 1/4) miles on the present township road to the south-east corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 - Sec. 33 Twp 12S - R. 20 E and terminate in the present Eudora County road, and vacate as county road; beginning at the east line of Haskell Avenue near the east end of eleventh street in the city of Lawrence, thence east one and one-fourth miles to the Roman bridge, thence south one-half mile to the south-east corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of sec 33 - Twp 12S - R. 20 E terminating at the above mentioned point.

Be and it is hereby granted subject to the approval of the Highway Commission, and that the county engineer be instructed to prepare papers for submission to the Highway Commission. This change eliminates 1/2 mile of county road.

A motion that stenography in the office of Probate Judge be paid one hundred dollars per month from and after April 1st 1923 until further action is taken. Passed unanimously.
