

Saturday April 21-1923-

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The Board of County Commissioners met in special ^{session} at 10 A.M. Present Kretzinger, Steele and Hosford. The Board approved the appointment of L.B. Read as deputy Sheriff. The Board approved the appointment of G.H. Lamb as Deputy County Surveyor. Motion regularly made & seconded passed by the Board unanimously - that plans and specifications for the Captian Creek & Hyland bridges having been approved by the ^{State} Highway Commission the county clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids for the construction of such bridges and that bids will be opened Monday the 16th day of May 1923 at eleven A.M. at the office of the County Commissioners in Douglas County.

The following resolution was passed unanimously that. The Banks of this County not under the Bank Guarantee law, having deposits of Douglas County funds, be instructed by the County Clerk, to file with the County Depository, Bonds in amount according to law.
