

Monday - May 7 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. Present: Kretzinger, Steele and Hosford. Monthly bills for the month of April were passed on by the board.

The bond of L. C. Carter, the newly elected Treasurer of Maple Grove Drainage District was approved.

The monthly reports of S. C. Siger, Supt. of County Home & Farm, Mrs. Emma J. Kennedy, Commissioner of the poor and Dr. E. R. Keith, Health Officer were approved.

On motion which carried unanimously the following described property was ordered to be marked exempt on the tax rolls, for the reason that it is county property:—

Block of ground bounded on the south by Pinckney (6th street) on the west by Vermont street, on the North by the right of way of the Santa Fe R.R. and on the East by Mass. street known as the old county jail site.

Wednesday May - 9 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present: Kretzinger, Steele and Hosford.

That whereas there was paid into the County Treasurer of Douglas Co, Kansas, by C. H. Tucker, executor of the estate of Ed^{2nd} Crutchfield, deceased, for the benefit of the school fund, money unclaimed by the heirs of Ed^{2nd} Crutchfield, deceased, the sum of \$83.25 and whereas checks drawn by said executor, before said money was paid into said Treasurer amounting to \$7.25, have since been presented by him; Therefore be it Resolved that said sum of \$83.25 be refunded to said C. H. Tucker, and an order drawn on the Treasurer for said amount.

The following resolution was passed unanimously.

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co, Kansas, in regular session this 9th day of May 1923, that upon the said defendant, Clyde McGee, paying the costs, in the case of the State of Kansas vs. Clyde McGee, the fine assessed in said action is hereby remitted, and the Sheriff of Douglas County, Kansas, authorized to release said defendant from custody at the expiration of the sentence of confinement in said case.
