

In the Matter of the Petition for Exemption of the Property of Sigma Nu Fraternity
Resolution.

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co, State of Kansas, in regular session this 9th day of May, 1923, that:

Whereas, the following described property; to wit:

Beginning at a point two hundred and sixty-nine²⁶⁹ feet north of, and eight hundred and eighty-eight (888) feet west of the southeast corner of the northwest quarter (N.W. 4) of Section thirty-six (36), Township twelve (12) South, and Range nineteen (19) East; thence east one hundred and forty feet (140); thence north ninety-six (96) feet; thence west one hundred forty (140) feet; thence south forty-one (41) feet; thence west one hundred and thirty-nine (139) feet; thence south thirty-five (35) feet; thence east thirty-two (32) feet; thence south seventy-seven (77) feet; thence east forty-five (45) feet; thence north seventy-seven (77) feet; thence east sixty-two (62) feet; thence south twenty (20) feet to the place of beginning, containing twenty-one thousand seven hundred and seventy (21,770) square feet.

is the property of the Nu Chapter of the Sigma Nu Fraternity, and that said property is exempt from taxation under Section No. 11151 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1915; therefore we, the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, recommend to the State Tax Commission that the above described property be exempt from taxation; and that the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, be instructed to mark "Exempt" following the description of the above described property on the Assessment and Tax rolls of Douglas County, Kansas.

Passed unanimously by the Commissioners.

Come now your petitioner, the Nu Chapter of the Sigma Nu Fraternity and respectfully shew to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Ks.

I. That said Sigma Nu Fraternity is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Kansas.

II. That said corporation owns and has occupied since February 1922 the following described real property; to wit:

III. That said above described real estate and buildings there on situated, is used exclusively by said corporation as a literary hall and dormitory.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that said real estate and buildings situated thereon, together with all tools, furniture, apparatus and instruments belonging to said corporation, be exempt from taxation.
