

of said patients in said Hospital, now therefore

Be it Resolved that in the future the Board will not consider the payment of any bills for the care of paupers in said Hospital, unless the placing of said individuals in said Hospital shall have had the approval of the Commissioner of the Poor and the County Health Officer, and no bills will be paid without the O. K. of said County Officials.

Be it further Resolved that the County Clerk be instructed to mail copies of this Resolution to the Memorial Hospital Authorities, the Health Officer of the County and the Commissioner of the Poor.

Passed unanimously by the Board of Commissioners.

May 16 - 1923 - Wednesday.

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session. Present Kretzinger, Steele and Hosford. The Fort to Fort Road Bills that were late in getting back from Topeka were allowed.

Mr. Hosford presented the application of Helen Snider for admittance to the State Sanatorium at Hoston, Kansas. The County Clerk was instructed to send the papers to the Sanatorium authorizing her admittance.

The following contract was entered into with the J. E. Catton Company.
