years from Jan 1st 1919; also to examine the official records and account of the Treasurer of said county, covering four years from Oct 1st 1919; and to make and file with the clerk of said second party a written report showing all errors, omissions and discrepancies if any which are disclosed from such examination. First party not required thereunder to check items of taxes on duplicate tax receipts against corresponding items on the tax rolls.

Said first party agrees to begin work within one-hundred-twenty days from date and to continue the same as speedily as possible consistent with accuracy, and to make such recommendations as in its judgement will improve the present system of accounting and reporting by the said officers.

The party of the second part hereby agrees, that when the examiners of the said first party have done and performed the services herein required of the first party, to pay said first party for such services the sum of two-thousand-four-hundred (\$2400.00) dollars of which two-thousand (\$2000.00) dollars to be paid upon the completion of the audit of the fee officers for the term mentioned herein and three years of the treasurer's office, final payment to be made on finishing the treasurer's office.
