P. H. Clopper K.C. No Bid \$16,630.32 on the Captains Creek Bridge, but failed to enclose a certified check. The bid was not considered and the clerk was instructed to return the bid to them.

On motion the Board adjourned, to meet at 2 P.M. to hear the recommendation of the engineer.

At 2 P.M. the Board heard the recommendation of the engineer and passed the following motion: That Brune Bros (Orel, Albert & Gals) of Lawrence, Kansas be awarded the contract for constructing the Captains Creek & Hyland Creek Bridges at a cost for Captains Creek of \$15,523.74 as per unit estimate and Hyland at \$2648.55 - their bids being the lowest and best bids and within the engineers estimate, and that the chairman be authorized to enter into contract upon their furnishing proper bond.
