

Board of Equalization

May 21-1923 - Monday.

The Board of County Commissioners met as a Board of Equalization on May 21, 1923 and on each day thereafter up to and including May 31, 1923, with the exceptions of Sunday (May 27th) and Memorial Day (May 30th). Very little business came before the Board for equalization and the following is a list of the changes made by the Board.

Brewer R. McNeese, 29-13-19, Clinton Sup. Improvement reduced from \$2,000 valuation to \$1,250 valuation.

Albert Salisburg, Blk. 31, West Lawrence, on West 5th Street. New house assessed at \$2,500, reduced to \$1,800.

Mrs. Louella Baker, Lot 17, Babcock Place; value of improvements reduced from \$1,500 to \$1,000.

Ed. Hooper; allowed exemption.

Mrs. Heath, Lot 51, Babcock Place; valuation of improvements reduced from \$200 to \$100.

Brownham, Munger & Root having moved away, their Personal Property assessment was reduced from \$5,115 to \$2,000. George Zollner; assessed valuation of horses reduced from \$150 to \$100.

C. G. Perkins, Lot 2, Block 11, Babcock Enlarged Addition; valuation reduced from \$4,000 to \$3,500.

Mrs. Adele Russell, Lot 52, N.Y. St. \$300 valuation on improvements remitted.

W. G. Bowman of Clinton Sup.; valuation on cattle reduced from \$500 to \$750.

Ed. Kaold, Lots 135 and 137, Indiana St. valued at \$1,500. and \$2,500 reduced to \$1,000 and \$1,500 respectively.

Mrs. Murphy, 933 Main St., Piano reduced in valuation to \$50.

Harley E. Fox, Lots 178 and 179 Rhode Island St.; \$300 for additional improvements removed.

S. C. Gilman, 28-14-20; valuation on Real Estate reduced \$150 because of fire in orchard.

Arthur Parker, Lot 37, Main St.; \$1,500 reduction in valuation asked, which was granted each year but not recorded on the records. The same confirmed.

C. L. Scott, Lot 13, Smith's Addition; valuation reduced from \$2,400 to \$2,750. April.

P. C. McHenry, Lots 26-27-28, Eighth St., Baldwin; Kansas. Valuation of improvements reduced \$400.
