

Board of Equalization Continued - 1923-

Application for equalization on Real Estate by Jerry Lyons is still before the Board and under consideration.

June 13- 1923 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session as a Board of Equalization. Present, Kistinger, Steuk & Hofford. Only Jerry Lyons and Sol Marks who had appeared before the board of equalization in its regular session appeared for final settlement on their claims.

The valuation the following land and improvements belonging to Jerry Lyons S61²/₄ of N.E. 4 of Sec 2-13-19- was reduced to \$65⁰⁰ per acre and the S.E. quarter sec 2-13-19- less 1²/₄ for school 159⁰⁰ was reduced to \$95⁰⁰ per acre. and the value of the improvements were reduced to \$800⁰⁰ same being actual value in money, in the judgement of the board of the several pieces of land and improvements as of Mar 1st 1922.

In the matter of personal assessment of Sol Marks his assessment was reduced \$1500⁰⁰ to \$7500⁰⁰ same being \$1500⁰⁰ more than his return.

The board adjourned as a Board of Equalization and recommended as the Board of County Commissioners.
