Tuesday June 6 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Kretzinger and Hasford. Bills were approved. Fred Kaptad of Grant Township made complaint that the Tax Rolls show that one (1) acre of land was taken from his 45<sup>th</sup> tract in 7-12-20 for the Road road, and that the county had not secured any land from the owner of the land for such road. The board satisfied themselves that the above facts were true and instructed the County Clerk to correct the Assessment and Tax Rolls.

The following Resolution was received by the County Commissioners from the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

"Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas which is a city of the second class, having less than 65,000 inhabitants, deems it expedient and advisable and a public necessity, to grade, curb, gutter, pave or otherwise improve south Missouri street and the country road connecting therewith from the south end of the present pavement on Missouri street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, at a point near the intersection of Eleventh street with the said Missouri street; thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered thirty-five to the road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 12, range 19, Douglas county, Kansas, thence south along said quarter section line following said road numbered thirty-five and also
