

Wednesday July 11-1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. G. E. Kretzinger, Rolt A. Steele & C. B. Hoeford present. The Board went over the general road affairs of the county with E. E. Trueblood, Co. Engineer.

It was ordered that \$100.00 be taken off the improvements on 2 1/4 in SE cor. of Add 7-7. Lawrence, land sold off same.

The quarterly report of the Sheriff, & the report of the Co. Health Officer for the month of June were approved.

The Road Petition signed by Fred Hultkuehle and 41 others was granted and the following Resolution passed:-

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co., in adjourned regular session this 11th day of July 1923 that the following described road to-wit: Begin at the SW corner of sec. 30 Twp. 17 N. Rg. 18 Thence North about 2 1/2 miles on range line between ranges 17 & 18 and terminating at the Fort to Fort Highway, be designated as County road to become part of the County road system of Douglas County, State of Kansas.

By direction of the State Tax Commission the Board ordered the cancellation of the 1923 personal property tax of the Alemannia Fraternity.

Saturday July 14-1923-

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session, C. B. Hoeford & Rolt A. Steele present.

The Board held a long conference with the Co. Engineer relation to important road matters of the county, and further reviewed complaints of parties relation to Fort to Fort Benefit district and a motion was made & carried to transfer the SE 1/4 of sec. 13 Twp. 17 N. Rg. 18 from zone B to zone C.
