

Monday Aug 6 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. Present Kietzinger, Steele and Mosford. Current bills were audited and approved or disapproved.

Mrs Emma Kennedy was elected by a unanimous vote to the office of Commissioner of the poor for two years.

The board passed unanimously a motion instructing the county clerk to make the following instructions to county Treasurer in regular form:

Transfer the Special Interest & Sinking fund account to the County Interest and Sinking fund account.

Transfer the Fort to Fort project #7 account to the Fort to Fort Bond account.

The Drainage district #4 account - transfer to the Maple Grove drainage district general fund.

Also that the county treasurer be instructed to cancel tax for 1920 on Y.M.C.A. lot in Peaire Add.

The following reports were received, filed and approved. Chairman Carl Phillips report of inquest on Walter Collins. C. G. Siger, report of Farm & Home Mrs Emma J. Kennedy, Commissioner of Poor. Dr. E. R. Keith Health Officer.

The board order a refund to Louise Towne of \$89.90 on personal property because liberty bonds had been assessed. Bonds for County Superintendent D. J. Lane and Long Star State Bank were approved.

That the court house of Douglas County be closed during the afternoon of Friday Aug. 10th. 1923, in order that the officers and employees of the Court House may attend the services being held in South Park in observance of the funeral of our late president.
